We need high resolution images that will be sharp and clear when enlarged to A3 size. Please ensure your photograph meets this requirement.

Entering the awards:

- The competition is open to all NFA members.
- Each organisation may submit as many entries as they wish.
- Receipt of entries will be acknowledged by e-mail within three working days of arrival.
- **Entries can only be accepted with a fully completed entry form (on page 2)**
- GDPR-compliant permissions must be sought from any identifiable person in submitted images.
- GDPR regulations stipulate that when people are asked for permission for the use of pictures that may identify them, they must be told in some detail how the pictures might be used. Please see the 'permissions' declaration on the entry form for further information.

Closing date for entries: 5pm on Friday 13th March 2020

Judging:

- The shortlist, selected by independent housing sector professionals, will be announced by the NFA and 24Housing on **Friday 20th March 2020**.
- Shortlisted images will be unveiled at the NFA photography exhibition and drinks reception on **Thursday 30th April 2020** at Hyatt Regency Hotel, Birmingham; attendees will vote for the winning image.
- The winner will be announced at the formal dinner held after the drink's reception. ALMOs whose entries are shortlisted are encouraged to invite residents featured in their competition entries to join us at the reception and dinner.
